## GOPB FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Governor's Office of Planning and Budget (GOPB) is looking for applicants with a strong work ethic, a desire to learn more about state government, and with experience or interest in one or more of our areas of [focus](#): Budget & Operations, Policy & Economic Analysis, Planning Coordination, and Results Management. As a fellow in GOPB, you will help drive the best investment and use of Utah's resources throughout your six-month experience.

### PROGRAM DETAILS

<b>Length of Fellowship</b>	Approximately 6 months.
<b>Hours</b>	About 20-30 hours per week.* <i>*Potential for additional hours</i>
<b>Pay Range</b>	Between \$17-\$26 an hour.* <i>*Dependent on education and experience</i>

### PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES

<b>Professional Learning</b>	Monthly lunch and learn sessions with leaders of agencies and other government entities and job shadow opportunities.
<b>Mentorship</b>	Fellows will be assigned a senior-level mentor.
<b>Job Shadowing</b>	Fellows will have the option to participate in a rotational opportunity with a GOPB partner entity as part of our professional exchange program.

### ELIGIBILITY

<b>Education</b>	Enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program, or recently graduated.
<b>Experience</b>	Participation in previous internships or past work experience in the area of interest is preferred.

<b>Deadline</b>	Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Fellowships typically start in January/February or July/August.
