You will work primarily with one of the [office pillars](#): Budget & Operations, Policy & Economic Analysis, Planning & Coordination, or Results Management while also learning about, and contributing to, the other pillars.

Length of Fellowship	6 months
Hours	20-30 hours a week* *Potential for additional hours
Pay Range	\$17-\$26 an hour (dependent on education and experience)

PROGRAM OPPORTUNITIES

Professional Learning	Monthly lunch and learn sessions with leaders of agencies and other government entities and job shadow opportunities
Mentorship	Fellows will be assigned a senior-level mentor
Policy Professional Exchange	Fellows will have the option to participate in a rotational opportunity with a GOPB partner entity as part of our professional exchange program

ELIGIBILITY

Education	Enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program, or recently graduated
Experience	Internship or work experience in the area of interest is preferred

Deadline	Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Fellowships typically start in January/February, April/May, or July/August
